Courses

EDU 100. Touch the Future. 3 Hours.

The course will explore the breadth of opportunities and careers in Education and the Human Sciences. Students' own experiences will be used as input for developing knowledge, behaviors, and dispositions necessary for success in college. Required for entering freshmen Education and Human Sciences majors. This course meets Blazer Core Local Beginnings Requirement with a flag in First Year Experience.

EDU 200. Education as a Profession. 3 Hours.

Formal introduction to the Teacher Education Program (TEP). Using writing and discussion, the class provides a clear and realistic understanding of issues involved in choosing education as a career. Writing is a significant component of this course.

EDU 210. Communication in EDU: Visually Communicating with Graphic Novels. 3 Hours.

Develop interpretative communication skills to comprehend, evaluate, and analyze content across intercultural and interprofessional topics. Refine interpersonal communication abilities through spoken, signed, and written expression, sharing information, reactions, feelings, and opinions in diverse contexts. This course meets the requirements for Blazer Core Communicating in the Modern World.
